Our retreat location is at the Sylvan View Retreat Center at Camp Hebron in Halifax, PA. This setting is in the mountains of beautiful upper Dauphin County, and features an all in one center with 34 comfortable motel-style rooms, each with its own private bath, as well as linens provided. We can accommodate 68 women with two women to each room. You may choose your roommate at registration the day of the retreat, or indicate whom you would like to room with on your registration form. Hebron’s conference rooms, meeting areas, game/recreation room, an outdoor prayer labyrinth, and beautiful grounds for walking contribute to the theme of our 11th Step Retreat: Prayer and Mediation. The retreat includes 2-night stay and five delicious meals (Friday Dinner- Sunday Breakfast) served buffet style in the spacious dining room, which features a fireplace, deck, and great view of the woods. This facility is handicap accessible with elevators between two levels and is air-conditioned.
